Instead of taking Old LaHonda for the last part of the climb to Skyline, I stayed on 84 the whole way, checking out the mudslides. Yep. Still there. Definitely safer using Old LaHonda, despite what the county thinks we should be doing.

Today was probably the busiest day on 84 in quite a while, giving the one-lane sections their first real test, and yes, it backed up quite a bit! I still got through pretty quickly, but figure you might be delayed maybe 8 minutes total if things are really backed up.
